Seminars, State License Exams Highlighted Event

The convention also offered credits toward plumbing and water conditioning licenses, and included seminars on the Minnesota Plumbing Code, RO troubleshooting, wastewater recovery and reuse, legal issues for business, and ion exchange resins. Verify Your License and Credits Before Renewal

Don't wait until the last minute to check the status of your water conditioning or plumbing license. Credits must be obtained prior to

December 31, 2017, in order to process license renewals. You can check the status of your license on the Department of Labor and Industry website.
